### 1. Introduction: Swiss Better Gold: Association - Initiative

The **Swiss Better Gold Association** is a non-profit industry association whose members represent key players of the gold industry, aiming at the support of artisanal and small-scale gold mining (ASGM) as well as the development of responsible gold supply chains from the ASGM producers to its members<sup>2</sup>.

In 2013, the Association entered a public-private partnership with the Swiss State Secretariat for Economic Affairs (SECO) through which the **Swiss Better Gold Initiative** was created. The Initiative seeks to provide technical assistance to ASGM producers and enhance social and environmental practices, in order to support their accreditation as **Swiss Better Gold** suppliers.

# 2. Swiss Better Gold: Visual identity, communication, trademark registration

The Swiss Better Gold Association has registered the following trademark "SBG Swiss Better Gold":

## SBG SWISSBETTERGOLD

The **SBG Swiss Better Gold** trademark is the common denominator between different actors and endeavours for the creation of responsible ASGM supply chains from mine to market, allowing clearer and more efficient communication and messaging.

The **Swiss Better Gold** denomination will be used on its own or associated with other terms, such as "Association", "Initiative", "programme", "escalator approach", "sourcing strategy", etc. Ex. **Swiss Better Gold Association**; **Swiss Better Gold Initiative** as well as **Swiss Better Gold escalator approach**; **Swiss Better Gold sourcing strategy**.

It is possible to use the abbreviation "SBG" for Swiss Better Gold. Ex. **SBG** Association, **SBG Initiative** as well as **SBG escalator approach**, **SBG sourcing strategy**.

However, the first use of the abbreviation in a document must always be clear. Ex. Swiss Better Gold (SBG).

### 3. Use of the trademark

The registered trademark is a combination of words and a figurative sign:

SBG SWISSBETTERGOLD

This trademark designates the activities undertaken by the Swiss Better Gold Association and the Swiss Better Gold Initiative and shall be used as the <u>main</u> reference.

Furthermore, for the sake of clarity and identification of each stakeholder of the Swiss Better Gold system, the following <u>additional options</u> are to be considered in each specific case:

As the visual identity and designation of the Association:

As the visual identity and designation of the <u>Initiative</u> for communications in English:

SBG swissbettergold

As the visual identity and designation of the <u>Initiative</u> for communications in Spanish:

### 4. Who can make Swiss Better Gold claims?

**Swiss Better Gold** claims can be made by:

- Swiss Better Gold Association members;
- Swiss Better Gold suppliers;
- Swiss Better Gold implementing partners;
- Swiss Better Gold institutional partners.

The **Swiss Better Gold Association** does not require its' members to make provenance or origin claims, nor product-related claims (i.e. 'off' or 'on' product). For more information, please refer to page 8.



All stakeholders shall strictly adhere to the present claims guide and need to <u>seek</u> a written permission from the **Swiss Better Gold Association** Secretariat to make any claims, which differ from provided examples (info@sbga.ch).

Since 2013, the Swiss State Secretariat for Economic Affairs (SECO) is the public partner of the **Swiss Better Gold Association**.

The **Swiss Better Gold Initiative** is a unique publicprivate partnership between the **Swiss Better Gold Association** and the Swiss State Secretariat for Economic Affairs (SECO), which aims at supporting ASGM producers on their journey towards better social and environmental practices.

Through creation of the **Swiss Better Gold Initiative**, the Swiss State Secretariat for Economic Affairs (SECO) and the **Swiss Better Gold Association** invest in activities to reduce poverty and improve social and environmental conditions in ASGM.

Through their public-private partnership named **Swiss Better Gold Initiative**, the **Swiss Better Gold Association** and SECO support ASGM producers to improve their technical, organisational, social and environmental practices, promote responsibly produced ASM gold, raise awareness and maintain an open dialogue with civil society on ASGM-related challenges.

### 9. Provenance claims for supply members

Supply members of the Association should be aware that corporate provenance claims are likely to come under scrutiny from regulators, investors, customers, and civil society organisations.

The Swiss Better Gold Association allows its members to make provenance claims about their ASGM sources participating in the Swiss Better Gold system. For avoidance of doubt, please note that <u>provenance claims are voluntary</u>.

Corporate provenance claims may include claims on gold being sourced directly from an ASGM producer participating in the Swiss Better Gold Initiative that follows a segregated processing route through a refinery, or a 'mass balance' sourcing strategy that blends gold from multiple ASGM producers or even includes gold from producers outside of the Swiss Better Gold system. In each case, these claims shall accurately reflect the quantities (in kilograms, grams or % of the total size of the batch) along with the origin of the gold and the degree of certainty about its



chain of custody. Claims shall be factual and shall not leave room for misleading interpretation of the members' commitments, the origin, and the amount of Swiss Better Gold in their custody.

Ex. We (or organisation) source gold from the Swiss Better Gold accredited producer XXX in Colombia;

Ex. We (or organisation) source X% of our gold from Swiss Better Gold accredited ASGM producers.

Members that choose to make such corporate provenance claims will be required to maintain evidence that these claims are substantiated by a documented management system and based on guarantees provided by their Swiss Better Gold refining partners (segregated production flows, transfer documents, etc.).

The Swiss Better Gold Association may also accept provenance claims assured by another recognised certification system. For example, a member of the Swiss Better Gold Association may also be an RJC member and have a voluntary provenance claim audited and certified by the RJC as part of its audit scope (CoP 14 on Provenance Claims and CoC). In such cases, the Swiss Better Gold Association would accept the RJC CoP certificate of that member as evidence of the claim's validity. In any case, these claims must be approved by the Swiss Better Gold Association Secretariat (info@sbga.ch).

### 10. Monitoring of claims

The Swiss Better Gold Association Secretariat is responsible for monitoring the claims made by different actors in the Swiss Better Gold system.

The Secretariat conducts a regular review of the claims made by Association members, Swiss Better Gold suppliers and implementing partners. These consist of a revision of the websites and social media channels.

A misuse is identified by the Swiss Better Gold team (Swiss Better Gold Association Secretariat, Swiss Better Gold implementing partner on the ground), a Swiss Better Gold Association member, or any other person/organisation.

If not identified by the Secretariat, a misuse can be directly communicated to the Secretariat via email or via the Swiss Better Gold grievance form (found under <a href="https://swissbettergold.ch/about-us">https://swissbettergold.ch/about-us</a>).

### 11. Misuse of claims

A misuse of Swiss Better Gold claims is defined as a breach with the Swiss Better Gold claims guide. It can be *minor* or *major*.



#### A minor misuse refers to:

- Claims, which slightly differ from the claims outlined in the claims guide and which haven't been consulted with the Secretariat.
- Overclaims, as in exaggerations.
- Claims including an affirmation of 'best practices', or an unjustified use of the words 'sustainable'/'sustainability'.
  - Words such as 'best practice' or 'sustainable'/'sustainability' should always be accompanied by a further qualification, e.g. 'continuous improvement to promote better practices', 'seeks to contribute to environmental sustainability', 'on our journey to sustainability'.
- Claims that assure the Swiss Better Gold supplier status of an operation that has not passed through a monitoring and/or verification process.
- False statements about a Swiss Better Gold Association member's status (supply or support member).

### A major misuse refers to:

- Misleading or deceptive statements about a Swiss Better Gold supply chain, e.g. false provenance claims.
- Claims that put in danger the reputation of Swiss Better Gold.

In the case of any misuse, the claimant is notified and asked to adjust or remove the claim.

In the case of a major misuse, the claimant may be asked to publicly rectify the claim.

In the unlikely event that false claims remain or are repeated after multiple notifications, the Swiss Better Gold Association Board of Directors will be involved to define corrective actions, potentially including termination of membership or participation in the Swiss Better Gold programme, publicly denouncing the false claim, barring continued/future collaboration, and/or initiate legal action.
